On October 8, 2024, The PEARL Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors approved the organization's first strategic plan. The Strategic Plan (the Plan) will serve as a guide for The PEARL Foundation, Inc., (The Foundation) and will reflect the organization's mission, vision, business operations, and action plans for its members and those served in the Cobb County community and the state of Georgia from October 2024 – December 2027. It will serve as The Foundation's Road map in delivering programs and services to the residents of Cobb County and the state of Georgia.

The Plan was developed to review the Foundation's mission, vision, values and priorities, and evaluate its strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats in an effort to ensure that all are consistent with the current needs of those served. The Plan reflects information gathered through Focus Group meetings or surveys with each of its constituent groups: The PEARL Board of Directors, The PEARL Advisory Council, The PEARL Foundation Members, Community Groups (including those served), Non-profit Board Representatives who serve Cobb County, Georgia, and The PEARL Foundation Board Members who serve on Non-profit or Foundation Boards of Directors.

The Plan's target area consists of serving constituents residing in the state of Georgia, with programming specifically directed to residents in Cobb, County, located in the north central part of the state and the third largest county.
